

"The clock, quite frankly, is ticking," said MacLean. "Now is the time. I want all the evidence we can get."

In what investigators called a "race to the courthouse," they are calling on those who have information in the case to come forward, before they begin knocking on doors. After all, information leading to an arrest is worth up to \$50,000.

"We'd like to think that there's some common good in everyone," said Williams, asking people to come forward with information. "We owe that to the citizens of Winona, and also to the family of Ada Senenfelder."

The Spotlight on Crime team is made up of agents from the Winona Police Department, the Winona County Sheriff's Department and members of the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension. Spotlight on Crime is a non-profit organization fund established by Minnesota businesses and the Minnesota Department of Public Safety, BCA, and state and local law enforcement officials. The fund is set up to provide rewards and assistance for cases which involve violent crimes against innocent victims where investigative efforts have been exhausted.
